# PROJECT GUIDELINES

## Projects must advance our common goals:

- Improve wellness using people centred models
- Connected, people-centred eHealth systems that *advance the vision*
- Be globally competitive and import useful ideas
- Support autonomous research and specialization
- Support commercialization locally and globally. Research with a real impact
- Basic or applied research (discovery or translational)
- A discrete but integral step in realizing the vision of a connected and people centred health system

# FUNDING APPROACH

1. Requirements and Opportunities
2. Funding sources identified
  - Big or small, as long as it is relevant to the vision
3. ARC and NYRIC members form response teams
  - Team is comprised of one or more researchers and at least one industry partner
  - Researchers should pragmatically team to win grant. More than one researcher is not essential because ecosystem supports autonomous specialization
  - More than one response team may apply for the same funding opportunity
4. Teams collaborate on proposal & obtain approval
  - Secure industry partner commitments
  - Secure commitment from research organization
5. Execute Project
  - Live testing and refinement, measure results
6. Publish and Promote Results
  - Get research recognized on a global stage

# SAMPLE OF UPCOMING GRANT TARGETS

- Networks of Centres of Excellence of Canada
  - Criteria for Grant: commercialization potential, benefit to Canada, strong track record, strength of business plan
  - Program Name: Centres of Excellence for Commercialization & Research
    - Typical Award: \$15,000,000 over 5 years
- NSERC - Strategy for Partnerships and Innovation
  - Criteria for Grant: industry / researcher collaboration
  - Program Name: Collaborative Research and Development (CRD) Grants
    - Typical Award: \$10,000 to \$500,000
  - Program Name: Idea to Innovation (I2I)
    - Typical Award: \$125,000 phase one
  - Program Name: Engage Grants
    - Award: \$25,000 over 6 months
  - Program Name: Interaction Grants
    - Award: \$5,000 over 3 months
- Canadian Institutes of Health Research
  - Criteria for Grant: : Industry-partnered Collaborative Research
  - Program Name: Proof of Principle
    - Award: \$160,000 first year
  - Program Name: Operating Grant
    - Award: \$500,000 per year
- Ontario Research Fund – Research Excellence
- Many more..
